

# NORTH DEVON TKD

Dear students & parents it has become obvious that some students are taking more and more liberties both in and out of classes.

So I am taking this opportunity to remind us all of some of the rules of the TAGB and North Devon TKD.

- Training fees is due in the first week of each month. Late fees automatically incur a late payment fine of £5 per person per month. If you are going to be absent in the first week then payment can be received before your planned absence rather than being late. If you are unable to attend class during the first week then let me know so I don't add the fine to your name.
- A late licence renewal automatically incurs a £5 fine & you will be unable to train until your licence has been renewed.
- Belts should be removed when consuming food or drink.
- No smoking when wearing your dobok regardless of wherever you are wearing it.
- Club student uniform is, and will remain as, white TAGB doboks or club t-shirt with white TAGB dobok trousers. Please ensure your uniforms are clean & ironed. Muscle vests & crop tops etc are not part of the club uniform therefore you will not be allowed to join in the class should you fail to dress properly.
- Anybody carrying an injury or feeling ill before class commences should not join in the class at all if you feel you may be unable to complete the class to the best of your ability.
- Please ensure you use the toilet facilities before or after class as toilet interruptions are disruptive to your fellow club members. Also please ensure you wash your hands as we all have hands on contact during parts of some classes.
- Please take a look at your toenails. Over the years I have suffered many cuts and scrapes from peoples 'talons'. I'm quite sure you would not want to receive a cut from someone else's toenails.
- Please remember to address your fellow club members, especially your seniors as Sir or Ma-am. If someone forgets to address the instructor properly I don't expect the rest of the class to be prompting and whispering 'Sir!' in the background. The instructor and the student should be the only people talking.
- If you are late for class please ready yourself quickly and quietly and wait to be invited to join in by the instructor. If you are more than 10 minutes late then you will have missed the warm up, the most important part of the class, so you will not be allowed to join the class on that occasion for your own safety.
